

**Member, Patient, or Provider must obtain pre-treatment authorization for the following services at least 48 hours in advance.**

**Note: Emergency and Urgently Needed Services do not require preauthorization. Preventative services do not require Prior Authorization**

- All Inpatient Admissions (including inpatient rehabilitation, residential treatment facilities) and behavioral health services (partial hospitalization and intensive outpatient programs for mental health conditions and substance abuse)
- Cardiac Rehabilitation
- Pulmonary Rehab
- Supervised Exercise Therapy (SET) for Peripheral artery disease (PAD)
- Home health agency care
- Home infusion
- Hospice
- Inpatient Hospital Acute
- Inpatient Psych
- Medicare Part B drugs \*Including Part B Chemotherapy/radiation drugs and other Medicare Part B drugs
- Opioid treatment program services – Inpatient yes
- Outpatient Diagnostic tests and therapeutic services and supplies
- Outpatient hospital observation
- Outpatient hospital services
- Outpatient mental health
- Outpatient rehab services (PT – Physical Therapy, OT – Occupational Therapy, ST – Speech Therapy)
- Outpatient Substance Use
- Outpatient surgery (outpatient hospital surgery and Ambulatory Service Center (ASC))
- Partial Hospitalization
- Prosthetics and Orthotics
- Services to treat Kidney disease – depends on facility/specialist type
- Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF)
